He works throughout Australia as an educational consultant, specialising in classroom management, engagement and workload reduction strategies for teachers.

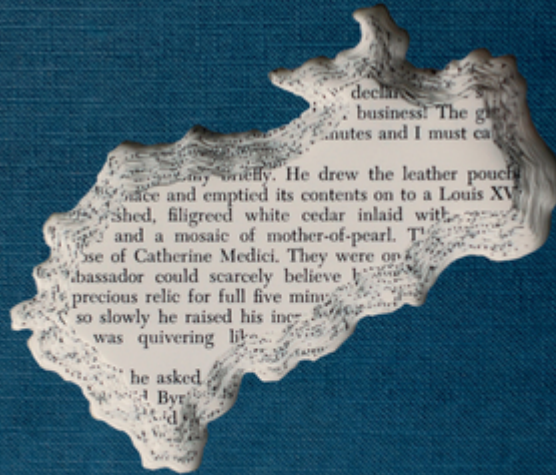
