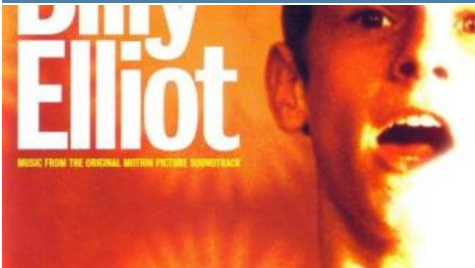


'Billy Elliot' - Module C -Texts and Society

This course will provide resources and strategies for teaching 'Billy Elliot' as a Module C 'Exploring Transitions' text.

Format: Face to Face - Individual

The workshop offers detailed focus on 'Billy Elliot' as well as conceptual links between the prescribed text and suitable related texts.

Module/Elective Basics

1 hour and 30 minutes

Clarifying the syllabus directions for 'Into the Wild' and how they can be used to teach the elective in an engaging way for students.

Deconstructing

2 hours

Close examination of the text both as 'film' and as an 'Exploring Transitions' text. The film's textual integrity as well as required knowledge and understanding skills required by students will be discussed. Filmic techniques and key scene analysis will be addressed via the workshop booklet and media presentation.

Related Texts and response skills

1 hour and 30 minutes

Evaluation of the various teaching and learning methods that can be used to develop student interpretation and response skills. Student exemplars as well as comments from the marking centre will be used to inform discussion and resource sharing.
